Don't wait until you are at the water's edge before you begin training for water work. All exercises, from Apprentice to Courier rely on the same fundamental skills that can be learned indoors or in your yard. Having a reliable and strong base to build on, will make advanced training more successful and fun. Join us for our pre-season training to help prepare you and your dog for this year's water work. **Novice Class**: This is for beginner dogs of any age. The focus will be on basic skills and how to

apply them to the Junior and Apprentice level tasks. A second session will be held in June at Lake Andrea (Date TBA)

Intermediate Class: This is for dogs who are training for the Working or Courier level. Dogs that completed the Novice class and are reliable, but have not yet achieved an Apprentice title are welcome & encouraged to begin learning more advanced exercises. A second session will be held in June at Lake Andrea (Date TBA)

Prior to the first class, it is recommended that you read the introductory section of the PWDCA Water Manual and download the exercise descriptions appropriate to your level of training. The manual can be found on the PWDCA website – <u>www.pwdca.org</u>

Things to bring with you:

- ➢ A crate for your dog
- Buckle collar and 6 ft. leash
- ▶ Long Line (recommended, but optional at this time) at least 20 ft.
- ➢ Water bowl and water
- Lots of yummy soft treats (2-3 different types)
- ➢ 1-2 retrieving toys or your water work equipment
